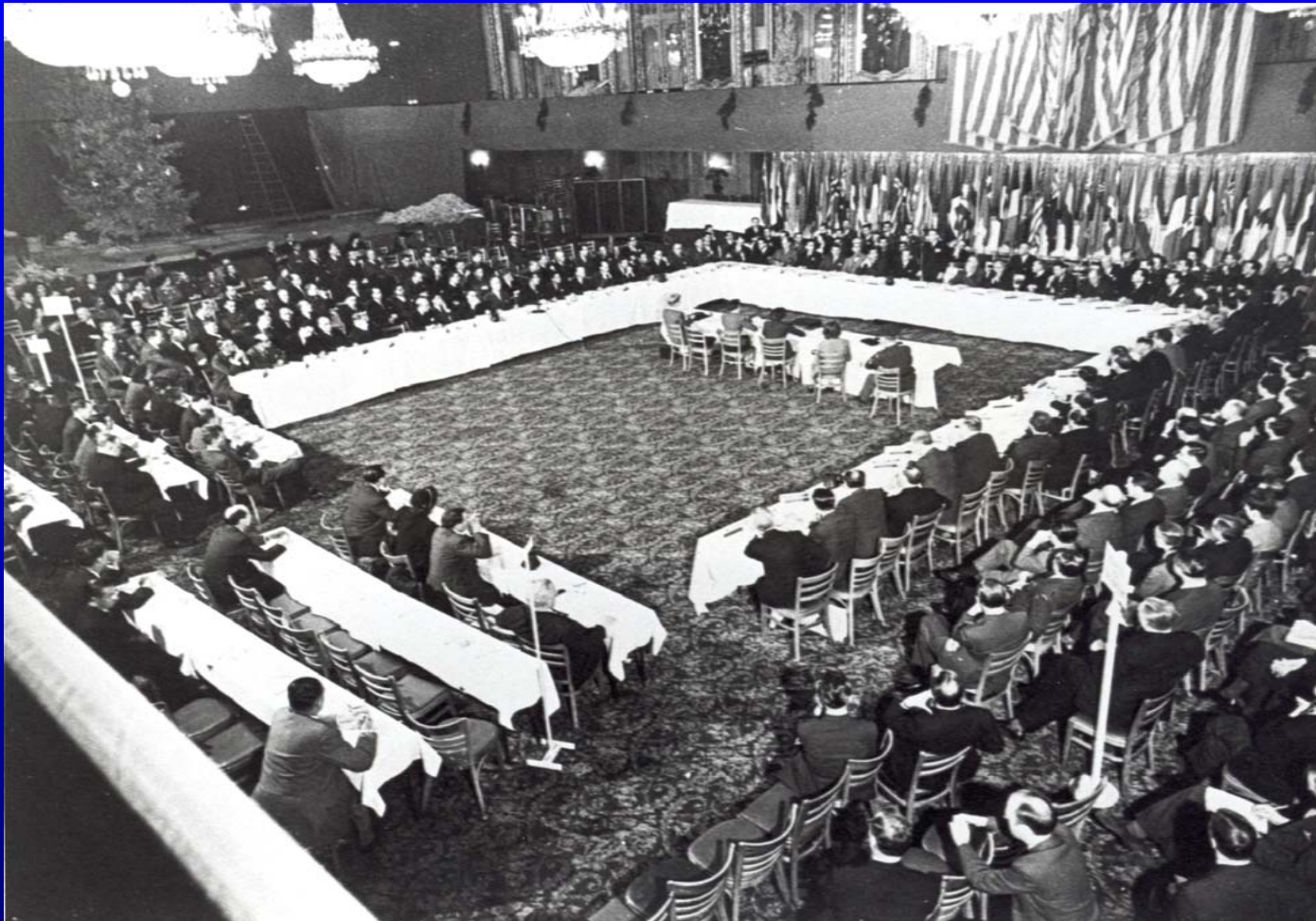

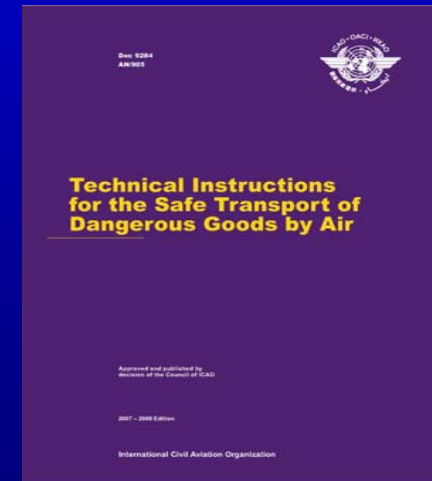

Chicago Convention

- ⇒ Convention on International Civil Aviation
- ⇒ Original Purpose
 - To ensure safety, efficiency, and regularity of air transportation
- ⇒ 7 December 1944 – signed by 52 States
- ⇒ 13 May 1947 – ICAO
- ⇒ 190 Contracting States

Achieved via....

- ⇒ Creation and updating of Standards in 18 Annexes
- ⇒ Annex 18 – The Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (8th edition – 25.11.05)
- ⇒ Technical Instructions



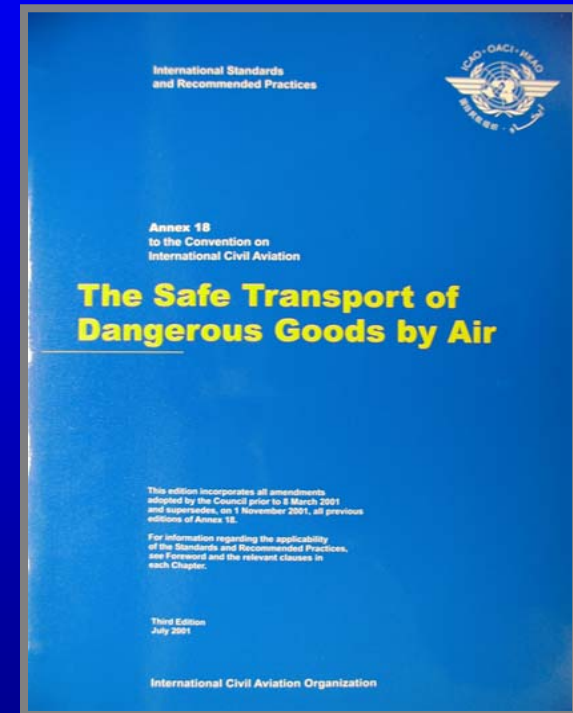
2.1 General applicability

“The Standards and Recommended Practices of this Annex shall be applicable to all international operations of civil aircraft.”

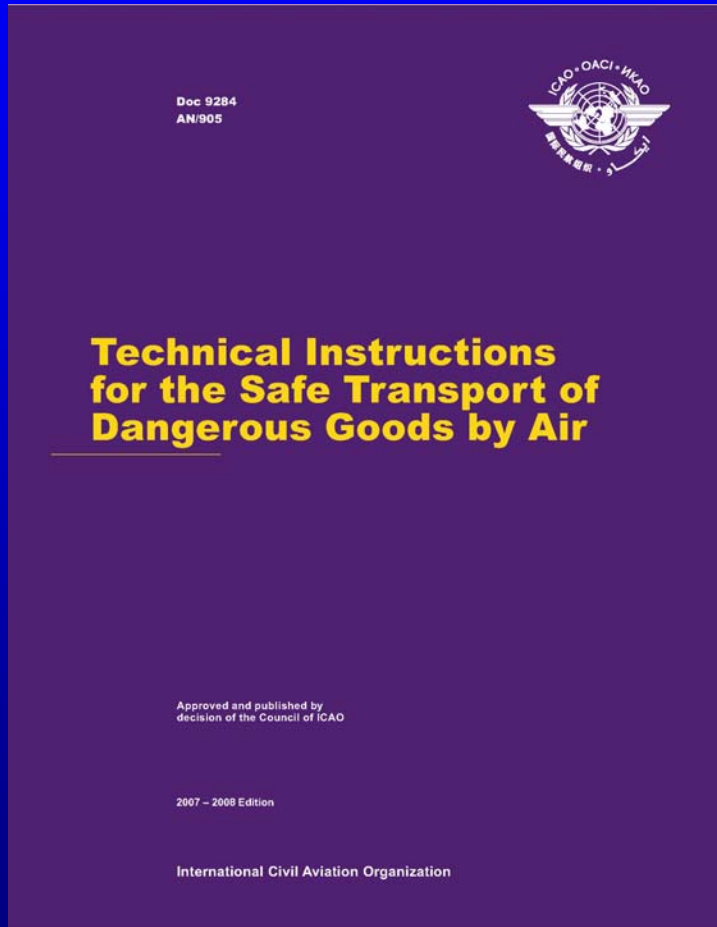
States concerned may grant exemptions from these provisions provided that there is an equivalent over-all level of safety in transport.

States concerned:

Origin, Transit, Over-flight, Destination of the consignment, State of the operator.

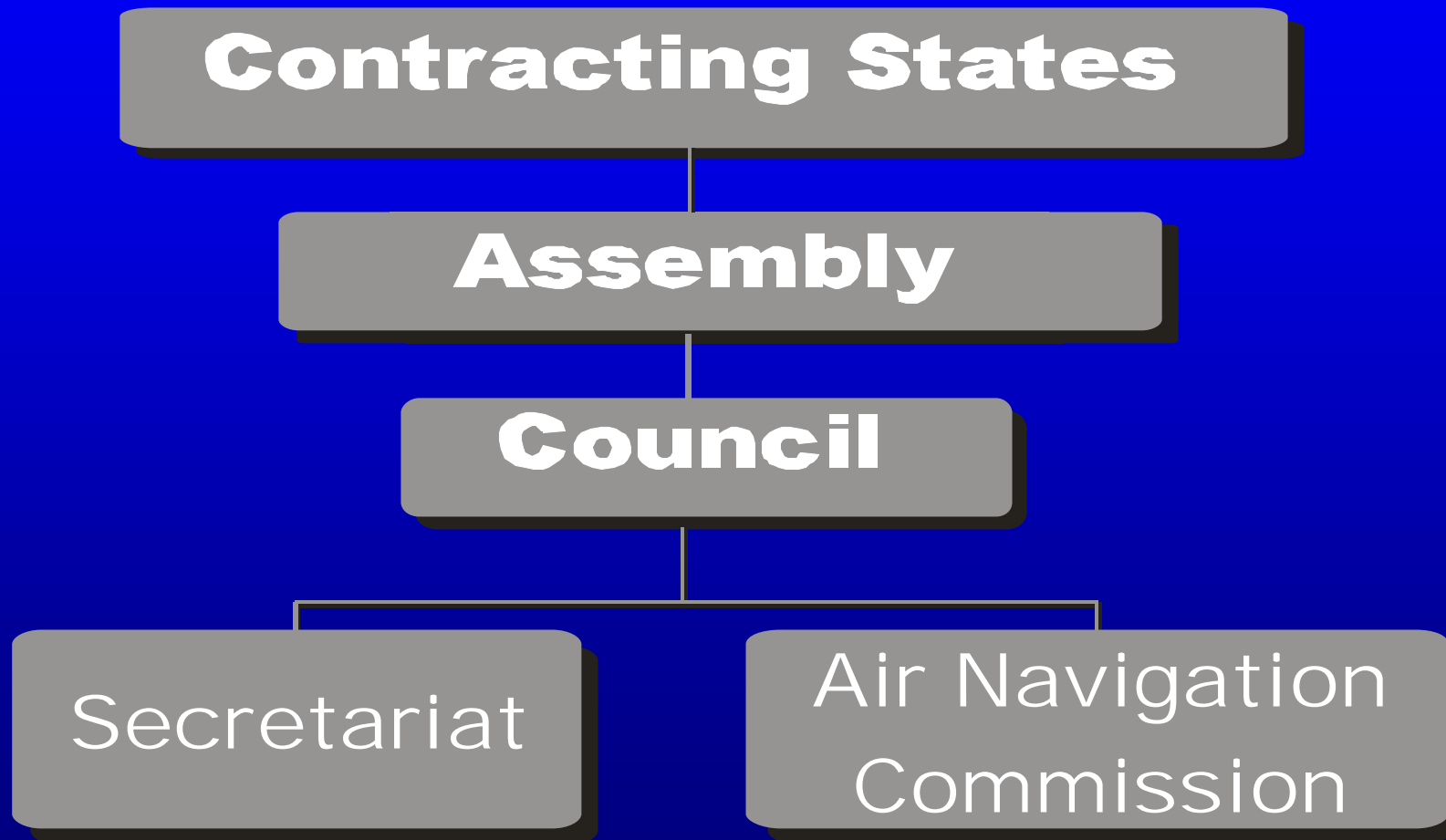


2.2 Dangerous Goods Technical Instructions



⇒ Each Contracting State shall comply with the Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc 9284-AN/905), approved, issued and amended in accordance with the procedure established by the ICAO Council.

ICAO Structure



Dangerous Goods Panel

- ⇒ Established by Air Navigation Commission
- ⇒ 18 members
 - 16 states
 - 2 international organizations
- ⇒ Biennial cycle to reflect UN cycle
 - Decisions of UNCOE December 2004
 - Applicable 1.1.2007
