

How to reach Schiphol Group's Head Office or 'het Schipholgebouw'



by car


from Amsterdam

- 1A Take the Schiphol motorway exit
- 2 Turn right at the first exit
- 3 Turn left at the traffic lights
- 4 First street to the left (Evert van de Beekstraat)
- 5 First street to the left (Energiestraat)
- 6 First street to the left (Triportweg) – P22 car park exit/entrance

from Rotterdam – The Hague

- 1B Take the Schiphol motorway exit (follow Cargo/Long Term Parking)
- 2 -
- 3A Turn right at the traffic lights
- 4 First street to the left (Evert van de Beekstraat)
- 5 First street to the left (Energiestraat)
- 6 First street to the left (Triportweg) – P22 car park exit/entrance

Walking route from the car park

Walk along the pavement at the end of the car park. Cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and walk straight ahead. This is Evert van de Beekstraat. The second building is Schiphol Group's head office or 'het Schipholgebouw'.

Public transport



by train

Amsterdam Airport Schiphol can be reached by direct intercity and local train services operating from many towns and cities and the neighbouring communities. If you plan to visit us, we suggest you consult the NS travel planner beforehand, see: www.ns.nl

You can reach Schiphol Group's head office or 'het Schipholgebouw' as follows:



by bus

- Take the escalator or moving walkway from the train platform to Schiphol Plaza.
- Walk outside to the bus stations.
- Take any one of the Schiphol Snetnet buses going to P30, bus numbers 190, 191, 198 and 199, which run every ten minutes.
- Get off at the 'Schipholgebouw' bus stop and walk to the entrance of the building. Follow the walking route marked in blue and report to reception.

When travelling by bus you must present a valid ticket: a 'strippenkaart' (bus and tram card) or a Snetnet day pass, which must be stamped by the driver, a public transport (annual) season ticket, a Snetnet pass or a Schiphol pass.
